The Monroe County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment on August 29, 2017, with Board of Supervisor members Michael R. Beary and John Hughes present.

Minutes of August 22, 2017, read and signed for approval by Board of Supervisors.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Hughes to approve and authorize a Loan Agreement and providing for the issuance of a General Obligation Building Demolition Note and providing for the levy of taxes to pay the same. The full resolution is on file with the Auditor.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning the bronze plaque design for the Monroe County Safety Center. The Supervisors have requested a draft of the plaque be prepared for further discussion at the next meeting. No action taken.

Discussion was held concerning the former jail facility removal/demo plans. Auditor Amanda Harlan reported that notification had been sent to neighbors concerning the asbestos removal per a DNR request. Harlan also reported that she is awaiting response from asbestos removal contractor Environmental Edge concerning adjustments to their insurance documents before final approval can be made. Engineer Jeremiah Selby stated that he is waiting on response from our insurance company to finalize the demo bid documents. No action taken.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Hughes to approve the amendment to the 28E Agreement with Southern Iowa Area Crime Commission Service Agency.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

SCISWA representatives present to review program details and discuss new recycling trailers. No action taken.
