

The Monroe County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment on March 20, 2018, with Board of Supervisor members John Hughes (Chairman), Dennis Amoss and Michael R. Beary present.

Minutes of March 13, 2018, read and signed for approval by Board of Supervisors.

At 10 am Engineer Jeremiah Selby opened five bids for the farm to market rock letting. Bids were received from Bruening Rock Products, Douds Stone LLC, L & W Quarries, Inc., Martin Marietta Materials and Cantera Aggregates LLC.

Motion Amoss and seconded by Beary to accept the recommendation of Engineer Jeremiah Selby to accept the low bids for rock on the twenty items as follows:

Bruening Rock Products: 1,200 tons for \$18,660
Douds Stone LLC: 22,920 tons for \$342,169.60
Martin Marietta Materials: 5,720 tons for \$73,898
Cantera Aggregates LLC: 480 tons for \$7502.40

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Amoss to set April 3, 2018, at 9:30 am for a public hearing to consider a request to reclassify a portion of 173rd Street to a level C, described as follows: a road commencing at the E ¼ Corner of the NW ¼ of Section 7, Twp. 72, Range 19 West; Thence West approximately 2,025 feet, all of roadway being in Wayne Township – Monroe County, Iowa; a distance of approximately 0.38 miles.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Discussion held concerning Sheriff Dan Johnson's vehicle impound and inventory policy. County Attorney Pabst will review and provide input at the next meeting. No action taken.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to approve Red Barn Saloon & Grill's liquor and outdoor service license.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Conservation Director Andy Wuebker present to inform the Supervisors that the Conservation Board hired Sam Jacobs at \$12 per hour for part-time seasonal technician. No action taken.
