

The Monroe County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment on March 27, 2018, with Board of Supervisor members John Hughes (Chairman), Dennis Amoss and Michael R. Beary present.

Minutes of March 20, 2018, read and signed for approval by Board of Supervisors.

Motion Amoss and seconded by Beary to approve the Department Head Committee recommendation to implement a 457/401a savings plan to be administered by the Retirement Investor's Club (RIC), an employer-sponsored voluntary retirement savings program for public sector employees.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Amoss to approve the Department Head Committee recommendation to use the \$1000 County ICAP grant for an AED for the Courthouse and to use the 911 Board's \$1000 ICAP grant for an AED for the Secondary Roads Shop, depending on 911 Board approval and eligibility requirements.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Amoss to approve implementation of annual sexual harassment training for County employees. The Department Head Committee will decide implementation processes and times at their next meeting.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to approve the first reading of Proposed Ordinance 41, Adopting the Monroe County Code of Ordinances 2018.

All voting aye. Motion carried.
