

The Monroe County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment on March 6, 2018, with Board of Supervisor members John Hughes (Chairman), Dennis Amoss and Michael R. Beary present.

Minutes of February 27, 2018, read and signed for approval by Board of Supervisors.

County Attorney John Pabst present for discussion of complaints regarding Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad (BNSF) blocking the road in and near Avery, on 180th and 165th Avenue. Pabst stated that he has been receiving complaints for ninety days and both he and Engineer Jeremiah Selby have made several attempts to contact BNSF but had not gotten a response.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to request that Pabst proceed with legal action to try to resolve the issue with BNSF.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Amoss to appoint Kenny Williams to Guilford Township Trustee and Virginia (Ginny) Henderson-Smead to Guilford Township Clerk.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Amoss to approve the 3rd amendment to the CROSS Region 28E Agreement.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to grant network access for the Auditor's Office laptop.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Discussion held concerning a zoning violation, specifically to sections 5B 1 & 2, in the Lazy Daz Ranch area by owners Douglas and Anne Stumpf. The owner contacted County Attorney Pabst with a proposal to resolve the issue. Pabst stated that he will send a letter giving them 90 days to comply with the Monroe County Zoning Ordinance prior to bringing suit. No action taken.
