

The Monroe County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment on May 22, 2018, with Board of Supervisor members John Hughes (Chairman), Dennis Amoss and Michael R. Beary present.

Minutes of May 16, 2018, read and signed for approval by Board of Supervisors.

Deb Zaputil of the Monroe County Hitting and Pitching Facility Association present for discussion concerning the repairs made to the facility. Zaputil requested that the contractor return to the facility to repair issues with the door alignment and covering exposed lights. Hughes will report back to Zaputil in one week on the status of her requests.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary for the County to pay for all repairs (material and labor) as opposed to a previous agreement for the County to pay for labor and the Monroe County Hitting and Pitching Facility Association to pay for material.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to approve the Treasurer's Monthly Investment Report as recommended by Treasurer Peggy VandenBerg.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to approve Treasurer Peggy VandenBerg's recommendation to abate the following taxes per Iowa Code 445.16: Phillip Eugene See, Albia City, Demolished/Removed Mobile Home: 2017/2018, \$118; 2016/2017, \$118.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Discussion held concerning the courthouse restoration/tuck-pointing process. Auditor Amanda Harlan contacted Renaissance Restoration and Tometich Engineering for estimates to draw up bid/spec documents but had not yet received responses. Harlan also contacted Dan Hunt but his schedule was too full for the project. Supervisors will revisit the issue at their next meeting. No action taken.
