Iowa Municipalities Workers' Compensation Association (IMWCA) representatives Ed Morrison and Lisa Mart were present to report on the County's four year history. The County's experience modifier decreased from 2015/2016 to 2016/2017 by .01. Morrison stated that the County's modifier was in good standing and continued focus on safety programs within the County would continue to decrease the modifier thus lowering expense.
