Minutes of October 3, 2017, read and signed for approval by Supervisors.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Hughes to approve the costs of the 2017 School Election and approve billing to Albia Community School District.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Discussion held concerning removal/demo plans for the former jail facility. Auditor Amanda Harlan reported that contractor Dan Laursen Excavating, DBA Asbestos Abatement and Inspections of Iowa, had provided the proper insurance documents and that the Notice to Proceed had been signed as of September 29, 2017. Supervisor Hughes authorized giving the contractor a key to the premise while work was completed. Work began on the morning of October 3, 2017. No action taken.

Discussion held concerning a septic system at Lazy Daz Ranch. County Attorney Pabst, ADLM representatives Dianna Daly-Husted and Cameron Willis and Zoning Administrator Juanita Murphy briefed the Supervisors on the Douglas Stumpf situation. No action taken.
