

City & Special Election Nov. 5, 2013

Absentee Ballots are now available for residents interested in voting in the Albia, Lovilia and Melrose City Elections and the Special County LOSST Use Change Election to be held Tuesday, November 5, 2013.

Absentee ballots for the City Elections and Special Election are available in the Monroe County Auditor's Office during regular office hours (Mon.-Fri., 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.).

Absentee Ballot request forms are available in the Auditor's Office; on the County's website www.monroecoia.us and on the Iowa Secretary of State's website www.sos.state.ia.us

You may also send a handwritten request with the following information:

Voters Name, Driver's License Number or last 4 digits of Social Security Number, Birthdate, Registered Address, Mailing Address (if different than registered address), Name and Date of Election. (**City & Special Election – Nov. 5, 2013**)

The request **must be signed and dated by the voter requesting the ballot**. Mail requests or hand deliver them to the office of: Monroe Co. Auditor, 10 Benton Ave. East, Albia, IA 52531.

- **Deadline to request Absentee Ballot by mail is Fri., Nov. 1, 2013 – 5:00 p.m.**
 - **Absentee Ballots must be postmarked no later than Nov. 4, 2013 and received by 12:00 Noon on Nov. 12, 2013**
 - **Deadline for Albia City Voters - to vote Absentee in- person in the Auditor's Office is Mon., Nov. 4, 2013 – 5:00 p.m.**
 - **Deadline for Lovilia City, Melrose City and Voters in the Unincorporated Areas of Monroe County to vote in-person in the Auditor's Office is Tues., Nov. 5, 2013 – 11:00 a.m.**
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Voter pre-registration deadlines for the City & Special Election, November 5, 2013 are as follows:

October 21, 2013 - Worry-free postmark date (mail-in registrations which are postmarked 15 days before the election are considered to be on time – even if received after the close of registration.

October 25, 2013 - Last day to pre-register for City & Special Election – Auditor's Office open until 5:00 p.m.
