

The Monroe County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment June 30, 2020 with Board of Supervisor members John Hughes (Chairman), Dennis Amoss (Vice-Chairman) and Michael R. Beary present.

Minutes of June 24, 2020, read and signed for approval by Board of Supervisors.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to approve the appropriations resolution as follows:

*WHEREAS, it is desired to make appropriations for each of the different officers and departments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, in accordance with Section 331.434, subsection 6, Code of Iowa.*

*NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe County, Iowa, as follows:*

*Section 1. The amounts itemized by fund and by department or office on the below schedule are appropriated from the resources of each fund so itemized, to the department of office listed in the first column on the same line of the below schedule.*

*Section 2. Subject to the provisions of other county procedures and regulations, and applicable state law, the appropriations authorized under Section 1 shall constitute obligations from the itemized fund effective July 1, 2020.*

*Section 3. In accordance with Section 331.437, Code of Iowa, no department or Officer shall expend or contract to extend any money or incur any liability, or enter into any contract which by its terms involves the expenditure of money for any purpose in excess of the amounts appropriated pursuant to this resolution.*

*Section 4. If any time during the 2020/2021 budget year the auditor shall ascertain that the available resources of a fund for that year will be less than said fund's total appropriations, she shall immediately so inform the Board and recommend appropriate corrective action.*

*Section 5. The auditor shall establish separate accounts for the appropriations authorized in Section 1, each of which account shall indicate the amount of the appropriation, the amounts charged thereto, and the unencumbered balance. The auditor shall report the status of such accounts to the applicable departments and officers (monthly) during the 2020/2021 budget year.*

*Section 6. All appropriations authorized pursuant to this resolution lapse at the close of business June 30, 2021.*
