

The Monroe County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment March 31, 2020 with Board of Supervisor members John Hughes (Chairman), Dennis Amoss (Vice-Chairman) and Michael R. Beary present.

Minutes of March 24, 2020, read and signed for approval by Board of Supervisors.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to approve an amendment to the Monroe County personnel policy relating to cell phone usage, benefits and other language changes.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Amoss to approve installation of an outdoor drop box at the courthouse.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary to leave lobbies open to the public at the Monroe County Courthouse and Facilities.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Beary and seconded by Amoss approve hiring Zachary Norris as a full-time jailer with a starting wage of \$18.42 per hour in the Sheriff's Office.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Amoss and seconded by Beary approve hiring Lynne Graham as a part-time jailer with a starting wage of \$12.83 per hour in the Sheriff's Office.

All voting aye. Motion carried.

Sheriff Dan Johnson was present to inform the Supervisors of maintenance issues relating to the boiler at the law center. Multiple water heaters have broken and there are many other instances of corrosion and leaking in the system. Johnson will keep the Supervisors informed as costs come in. No action taken.
